

Two Mobile Health Units deployed to a regional Queensland hospital as a temporary Emergency Department





Deployment of multiple MHUs to Longreach Hospital

Background

Longreach Hospital is the region's major healthcare facility offering 31 bed inpatient care, 24-hour emergency department, pharmacy and medical imaging services, elective surgery, maternity services and a dental hub. There are 4308 people living in the hospital's catchment area. The facility is located 685 kilometres by sealed road from the Rockhampton Base Hospital, 1176 kilometres from Royal Brisbane and 1171 kilometres from Princess Alexandra Hospitals.

With the hospital's Emergency Department and Operating Theatre to be renovated and updated, Central West Hospital and Health Service under guidance by Queensland Health Capital and Asset Services Branch contracted two Aspen Medical Mobile Health Units (MHUs) to provide cover during the works. In total, the MHUs were in place for 15 weeks at Longreach Hospital.

- remote location.
